XEN0063 WebQuest on culture - Final report

As a final task of the course, you are asked to write a reflective report (of about 3 pages) of your working process. The report is to be written in English, and you should reflect on both yourself as an independent learner in this course and your ideas on the content of the WebQuests. Discuss at least the following topics and comment on:

- the use of the Internet as a source of information in the course and also as a channel for following how the course proceeds and checking the tasks on-line?
- completing the course using mainly computer?
- the role of the tutors during the working process. Did you get enough instructions, feedback and comments from the tutors? Would it be possible to complete the course without the tutors? Were the instructions clear enough?
- completing the course independently? What was easy, what was difficult in working by yourself?
- did you learn anything new / did you obtain new information during the course? What did you learn?
- did your perceptions of the themes introduced in the WebQuests change when working on the tasks?
- do you think you will use the information in the future? (in your studies, working life, life in general...?)
- what do you think about the themes of the WebQuests at the moment? (for example, you can compare the history and immigrant policy of Ireland and Britain with that of Finland etc.)
- did you mainly concentrate on the content and the themes of the WebQuests or the language when working on the tasks? (or both?)
- did you have any positive learning experiences? Any frustration or other negative feelings?
- any suggestions or tips to the tutors? How would you change the course/the tasks/how the course was run?
- work load and the time spent on the WebQuests? Was it too little, enough or too much?
- what kind of advice would you give to a student who wants to complete the WebQuests? What would you tell him/her?
- any other comments are also welcome!
